Spanair is the first Spanish network airline and full flight services departing from Barcelona and the second airline regarding to passengers volume in El Prat Airport. Spanair currently operates more than 200 daily flights, in 20 national destinations and other 20 international destinations in Europe, Africa and Middle East. Spanair was born in December 1986. Sixteen months later, its first plane took off in Spain in a charter flight from Son Sant Joan Airport, in Majorca. Since then, more than 112 million passengers have flown with Spanair. Thanks to its commercial agreement with Brussels Airlines, passengers from Brussels can now easily connect onto the wide domestic Spanish network of Spanair, including the Balears and the Canary Islands. Since June 2010 Spanair has become a full BSP member for the Benelux sales area.
